About Archbishop Bolen

Archbishop Donald Bolen studied at the University of Regina, St Paul University in Ottawa, and the University of Oxford. He was ordained a priest on October 12, 1991, for the Archdiocese of Regina, was named Bishop of Saskatoon on December 21, 2009, and was most recently appointed as the eighth Archbishop of Regina on July 11, 2016.

As parish priest, he served in a number of parishes in the Archdiocese of Regina; as the Chair of the Archdiocesan Ecumenical Commission; and as Vicar General of the Archdiocese. He also taught in the Religious Studies department at Campion College, University of Regina. From 2001-2008 he was assigned to work at the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, Rome, staffing the Catholic Church's international dialogues with Anglicans and Methodists, and co-chairing the international committee in charge of preparing texts for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.

Presently, Archbishop Bolen is a Member of the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, Co-Chair of the International Anglican-Roman Catholic Commission for Unity and Mission, and Co-Chair of the national Anglican-Roman Catholic dialogue. He has also served on international dialogues with Methodists and Evangelicals, and written and lectured widely on ecumenical relations.
