




First Lesson: Exodus 20:1-17 L: Word of God, Word of Life. **C: Thanks be to God.** 


#### Psalm 19

- L: The heavens are telling the glory of God; and the firmament proclaims his handiwork.
- C: Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night declares knowledge.
- L: There is no speech, nor are there words; their voice is not heard;
- C: yet their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In the heavens he has set a tent for the sun,
- L: which comes out like a bridegroom from his wedding canopy, and like a strong man runs its course with joy.
- C: Its rising is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the end of them; and nothing is hid from its heat.
- L: The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul; the decrees of the LORD are sure, making wise the simple;
- C: the precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the LORD is clear, enlightening the eyes;
- L: the fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever; the ordinances of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.
- C: More to be desired are they than gold, even much fine gold; sweeter also than honey, and drippings of the honeycomb.

- L: Moreover by them is your servant warned; in keeping them there is great reward.
- C: But who can detect their errors? Clear me from hidden faults.
- Keep back your servant also from the insolent; do not let them have dominion over me.
   Then I shall be blameless, and innocent of great transgression.
- C: Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable to you, O LORD, my rock and my redeemer.


