


Welcome to Glory Lutheran Church

First Lesson:

Isaiah 6:1-8

- L: ¹ In the year that King Uzziah died,
I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lofty;
and the hem of his robe filled the temple.
² Seraphs were in attendance above him;
each had six wings:
with two they covered their faces,
and with two they covered their feet,
and with two they flew.
³ And one called to another and said:

[Congregation sings:]

**“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; (repeat)
the whole earth is full of his glory.” (x3)
(Holy is the Lord.)**

- L: ⁴ The pivots on the thresholds shook at the voices of those
who called, and the house filled with smoke.
⁵ And I said: “Woe is me! I am lost,
for I am a man of unclean lips,
and I live among a people of unclean lips;
yet my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts!”

your guilt has departed and your sin is blotted out.”
⁸ Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying,
“Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?”
And I said, “Here am I; send me!”


Psalm 138
