A February/March edition will be published on Feb. 25, to feature the start of Lent and its activities as well as welcome our new council!



As you are probably aware, February is Black History Month. Our Synod office provided a list of resources including the video “Secret Alberta, the Former Life of Amber Valley” about one of the first and largest Black communities in our province.

Winner of the 2018 Canadian Screen Award for Excellence in Digital Storytelling. About 100 km North of Edmonton is Amber Valley, one of the first all-Black settlements in Canada. Arriving in 1909, the pioneers of this community battled the elements and racism to not only survive but thrive.
