**and is seated at the right hand of the Father.**

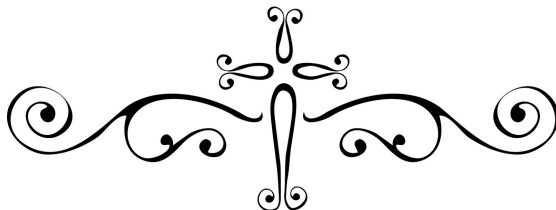

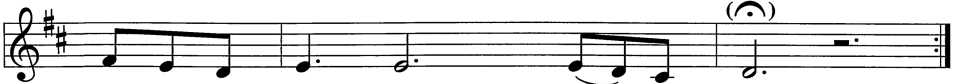
